### The Pending Dobbs Decision – How is a Catholic to Respond?

The leaked draft of the pending U.S. Supreme Court case of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* has returned the abortion debate to center stage in our already polarized culture. Despite the media frenzy and political posturing there are many important things we can do as people of faith by focusing on the needs of women and their children:

† **Pray!** Pray for the day when every unborn child is protected and every mother is supported.

† **Support Women in Need through Catholic Charities:** The majority of those served by Catholic Charities in the Diocese of Youngstown are women and children. For instance, last year Catholic Charities' *First Step* programs provided formula, diapers, wipes and other essential baby items to 2,971 low-income people who looked to the church in their time of need.

† **Act on behalf of Moms in Need:** Parishioners can play a critical role in strengthening the connection between women in need and resources available. ## MASS AT SAINT ROSE AT 5:30PM ON SUNDAYS

In June of 2019, the late Bishop George Murry promulgated a regional pastoral plan for all parishes in the Diocese of Youngstown. Part of the plan was to limit according to Canon law the number of regularly scheduled weekend Masses a priest could celebrate to three (3). At that time the 5:30pm Sunday evening Mass was permitted as long as a pastoral need was necessary. This Mass was celebrated with the help of neighboring priests. Since January of 2022 each parish has been counting the number of individuals attending weekly. The 5:30pm Mass at Saint Rose has a consistent drop in attendance. Therefore due to a lack of attendance the 5:30pm Sunday Mass will cease as of July 1, 2022. The last scheduled 5:30pm Mass will be celebrated on June 26, 2022. Please note that Saint Columba Cathedral does have a 4:00pm Sunday Mass. Thank you.
