### VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO CUT PEPPERS:

### TCAP SUMMER CRISIS PROGRAM

Trumbull Community Action Program (TCAP), 1230 Palmyra Rd SW, will be operating Summer Crisis Program through September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Eligible applicant/households may qualify for one or a combination of the following: an air conditioner and/or fans (if no air conditioner and/or fans was received from TCAP in 2019, 2020 or 2021); a one-time payment for the regulated electric bill not to exceed a total maximum benefit of \$500.00 or not to exceed \$800.00 for unregulated electric portion of bill. Eligible applicants must meet one of the following criteria: (1) Households with a household member age 60 or older, no medical documentation is required. Households whose electric has been shut off, or is in threat of disconnection, or new service is being established or transfer of service or deposit. (2) Households under the age of 60 with documented medical conditions by a physician. (3) Customers who are enrolling in the Percentage of Income Payment Plan Plus (PIPP) for the first time or have a PIPP default. (4) Disconnect notice not required to receive a benefit.
